

Typed, handprinted, or written copies of documents, not certified as 'True Copies', are not acceptable as proof. Published or manuscript material authored by the applicant or his family will not themselves be accepted as proof. Information for on the basic application. Oral, written, or published family traditions are often wrong, and are NOT accepted as proof.

ALL PROOF DOCUMENTS MUST BY THEMSELVES. OR IN COMBINATION WITH OTHER DOCUMENTS, ACTUALLY STATE THE FACT TO BE PROVED.

MPLIED EVIDENCE IS NOT ACCEPTED AS PROOF.
